INTERNSHIP SCHOLARSHIPS

Cather Circle awards scholarships to students who have accepted unpaid or low-paying internships that will offer an exceptional opportunity to work in their chosen fields of study. Internships are expected to last at least six weeks.

Eligibility Requirements

Cather Circle Collegians who have completed their freshman year may apply.

Application Process

A student must submit her current resume along with a statement describing the internship and how it will impact or advance her career path. The application also must include a letter from the prospective employer that clarifies the duties and responsibilities associated with the internship. **Applications should be dropped off to Sarah Haskell's attention at the Wick Alumni Center no later than Friday, Jan. 13, 2012, or e-mailed to her at shaskell@huskeralum.org.**

Criteria

Financial need as well as the skills and experience to be gained from the internship are both factors in the selection process. The number and amounts of the scholarships vary. **Recipients will be notified in late February.** An announcement of the scholarship winners will be made at the Cather Circle's spring meeting.

Scholarship payments

Stipends are given in two installments. The first distribution will be made at the start of the internship. Following completion of the program, the second installment will be made after final student evaluations are received and approved by the Cather Circle Internship Committee.
